Also we have bring women team do retreat at the retreat we teach them about great love from God We bring them to ocean most of the women never been to ocean so they love it and really thankful to God.

However, This year our government has been building a school there so most of the children no longer have to cross over by boat to school. The other good news that we have found out is that they will be bringing electricity to the island for the people to use there. This is really good news! 😊, Also they has been build road at the Island also.

We also have 23 boys build the team for football so they can play with other church and school.

Thanks to our God, this is a summary of the activities carried out by Correspondence Bible School during 2016 from Mexico City.

1. New students registered: 16,188.
2. Distributed and handed out 40,800 Bible tracts.
3. Broadcasted 156 hours of God's Word on radio.
4. Sent 5,830 Bibles to people who did not have one yet.
5. Reached 5 universities with our Bible courses.
6. Students graduated: 2,080.
7. 433 students were baptized.
8. We serve 203 prisons.
9. We enrolled 1,884 new prison inmates.
10. We gave biblical and psychological counseling to 984 people.
11. We planted 5 new churches.
12. 8,000 cops were trained with the Word of God. The change was noticeable drastic. Trained policemen are no longer extortionists; they treat people with kindness and respect.
13. We ship 47,142 packages of courses to students from 42 countries.
14. We ship 208 CDs recorded with Bible study.
15. Have registered 816 people to Bible courses from Muslim countries.

Glory to Christ, my beloved bro!

This is my brief annual report for 2016.

1. IMMERSIONS. We immersed 28 men (16 Russians, 3 Abkhazian, 1 Swan, 2 Ukraine, 2 Crimea Tatars, 1 Greek, 1 German, 1 Kirghiz, 1 Uzbek), four of them – the convicts, being in the penitentiary places.

2. PRISONS. We visited prisons, prison camps and detention cells 74 times.

3. MOSLEMS. Khalifate had big attacks in Berlin, Nice, Brussels, New York.

4. MISSION GEORGAPHY. Our mission worked in Russia (Krasnodar Territory, Tuva Republic, Astrakhan area, Irkutsk area, Saratov area, Moscow), Crimea, Ukraine controlled part of Donetsk area, Abkhazia, Kirghizstan, Uzbekistan.

5. MEDITATIONS. The main fruit of my meditations is the equation of Donald Trump with Tom Sawyer (watch: <http://isaurian.blogspot.ru/2016/12/tom-sawyer-president.html#more>).

6. DIVINE ACTION. Using of my discoveries and methods to work with Moslems is the realization of the Isaiah prophecy: “The calf and the young lion and the fatling together; and a little child shall lead them” (Is., 11:6). And this is the Divine Action, indeed! Alleluia!

7. YOUTH MINISTRY. The third book (Evangelization tale) of our daughter Nika was printed (2 000 copies). It was spread free in 15 congregations in Russia, Ukraine, Moldova and Germany.

8. PUBLIC RELATIONS. I had 8 public lectures on Christian themes at “Gamaliel school”.

9. REPRESSIONS. Russia adopted the “Yarovaya” law – a strict anti-missionary law. The deportations of the American missionaries, the prohibitions of public actions and penalty payments took place.

10. SUPPORT. We received the January, February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November and December ARM support and ARM Christmas gift through Max Goins “We-Go” system OK.

We received also the e-mails, letters and phone calls of support from Joe Garman, Ziden Nutt, Max Goins, Bill Blair, Nikolay Plutenko, Ten-Kuang Chang, Rick Deighton, Hymman Wood (USA); Felix Corley, lord Hylton, Tony Blair (UK); Gerhard Leiser (Germany); Y. Sillard, J. Weber (France); L. Prishchenko (Ukraine), Ali Hamzin (Crimea); Sultanmurat (Kazakhstan). My sister Nathaly sent to us from Moscow the Longfellow’s poem “Evangeline”; we received also the new issues of “Grace and Truth” journal (reformed Christian Church of Israel), “Religion and Society in East and West” (Zurich, Switzerland, the subscription is donated by pastor G. Leiser); the “Partners in Research for Development” journal (Australian Government).

We spread among the convicts and their relatives different fruits and vegetables, nuts, sweets, biscuits and tea, donated by Krasnodar brethren.
